Outside gas and diesel fuel sales average 80,000 gallons a month, and inside sales average \$30,000 a month. Store has two 10,000 gallon tanks and blender and two (10,000 and 13,000 gallon) tanks for diesel, two dual MPDs and Veeder Root tank and line monitoring system. This 1,200 ft ² store with its popular drive-thru window was remodeled in 2000 and has a 600 ft² adjoining office which is rented out for \$500 a month, or could be used to expand store space. Owner is ready to retire and is asking \$850,000 plus inventory for this unique opportunity. Current A/R of about \$125,000 can also be purchased at a discount.
